

Those who meet the Japanese language proficiency standard of B1 or above in the "Reference Framework for Japanese Language Education" defined by our school under the entrance fee exemption system are as follows.

- 1 Have Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N3 or above certification.
- 2 Have scored 420 or above on the BJT Business Japanese Proficiency Test.
- 3 Have been certified at level F or above on the “J.TEST” Proficiency Test in Practical Japanese or have scored 500 or above on the D-E level exam.
- 4 Have Japanese language NAT-TEST Level 3 or above certification.
- 5 Have scored 500 or above on the STBJ Standard Business Japanese Test.
- 6 Have been certified at intermediate level C or above in the TOPJ Practical Japanese Proficiency Test.
- 7 Have been certified at or above B1 level in the Certificate of Japanese as a Foreign Language.
- 8 Have been certified as JCT 3 or higher on the JLCT Japanese Language Proficiency Test for Foreigners.
- 9 Have been certified with A+ or higher in the Practical Japanese Communication Test Bridge (PJC Bridge).
- 10 Have scored 430 or above on the JPT Japanese Language Proficiency Test.
